As recommended by the Empowered Committee and in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Special Provisions) Act, 2010, sanction is hereby accorded to the regularization of following two (02) adhoc/ contractual/ consolidated employees of Revenue Department against the post/ pay scales held by them, prospectively, in relaxation of upper age bar indicated against each:

The regularization shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- I. The said appointees have not been selected by any recruiting agency/ or appointed in any other Government Department.
- II. The allowances other than what were admissible/ due have not been drawn and the excess allowances, such as HRA/CCA and MA, if any drawn/ paid to them shall be recovered.
- III. The incumbents are working against clear vacancies/ posts.
- IV. The said incumbents shall report to the Deputy Commissioner, Bandipora and Ramban who shall allow them to join subject to the production of following certificates/ documents in Original:
 - a. Academic/Technical Qualification Certificates.
 - b. Date of Birth Certificate.
 - c. Health Certificate issued by the Competent Authority.
 - d. Permanent Resident Certificate.
 - e. Relevant Category Certificate (in case the candidate belongs to reserved category).

- f. Certificate from General Manager, DIC, concerned and Deputy Director Employment concerned to the effect that no loan under self employment scheme has been taken.
- V. The incumbents shall initially be on probation for a period of two years.
- VI. The salary of these incumbents shall not be drawn and disbursed unless a satisfactory report about the verification of their character and antecedents is received from the Inspector General of Police, CID, to whom a reference shall be made by the Deputy Commissioner concerned.
